This technique eliminates the need to use any binders on our product.

## HERE ARE SOME REASONS TO MAKE THE SWITCH TO CUBEIT:

**Sun-cured alfalfa hay**: We let it sun-dry and harvest in large bales for storage. When filling an order, we grind the hay for the production of cubes.

**No added dyes**: We store our hay in enclosed buildings or under tarp cover to keep it green and protect from bleaching.

**No sodium bentonite added:**Our cubing process does not require a binder.

**Only top quality:**Our standard of quality is second to none. We will never compromise on the purity of our cubes for profit.
